PremiAero Limited Privacy and Data Protection Policy

Introduction

PremiAero Limited ("PremiAero") is a private company registered in the Bailiwick of Jersey, having its principal place of business at 2nd Floor, The Le Gallais Building, 54 Bath Street, St Helier, JE1 1FW.

PremiAero is involved in trading, asset management, lease, and consultancy services in the aviation industry (the "Services").

PremiAero acknowledges and value your right to privacy and takes seriously its responsibilities in relation to the processing of personal data. It does not collect, store or process personal data unnecessarily.

In order to conduct its business PremiAero has to gather and retain certain information about those persons with whom it transacts. Its privacy and data protection policy (the 'Policy') is written in accordance with the requirements of the Data Protection (Jersey) Law 2018. The Policy explains how personal data that we collect from you, or that you provide to us is being processed and treated.

Situations when PremiAero collects information.

The information you provide to us

PremiAero will collect and process the following data about you.

Your Data: This is information about you that you provide by corresponding with PremiAero by phone, e-mail or by filling in forms on our website or otherwise.

The information you give us may include:

- Identity Data: your full name, address, e-mail address, phone number, title and personal description.
- AML Compliance Data: your Identity Data, passport number and details (including photograph) and proof of address.
- Financial Data: your financial, including bank account details, billing contact email address and VAT number.

The information we collect in relation to the website use

Automatically collected Information as a result of using our website or files storage software. The following information may be collected automatically:

- Technical Data: technical information, including the Internet protocol (IP) login information, browser information, time zone, statistics of using the application or data upload.
- Usage Data: information about your visit, including URL, time on the website, pages viewed, response times, etc.

We do not require or collect any personal data unless you decide to provide this information to us.

We do not knowingly attempt to process or store any information from children.

Length of time information is held

PremiAero will only retain your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements. This means that the period of time for which we store your personal data may depend on the type of data we hold. To determine the appropriate retention period for personal data, we consider the amount, nature, and sensitivity of the personal data, the potential risk of harm from unauthorised use or disclosure of your personal data, the purposes for which we process your personal data and whether we can achieve those purposes through other means, and the applicable legal requirements.

How PremiAero keeps your information secure

PremiAero uses modern storage and security techniques to protect your personal information from unauthorised access, improper use or disclosure, unauthorised modification or accidental loss. Only authorised members of staff have access to online records. These records are password protected.

Despite all of our precautions however, no data transmission over the internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. So, whilst we strive to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee the security of any information which you disclose to us and so wish to draw your attention that you do so at your own risk.

Whilst we hope it will never happen, we have procedures to deal with any suspected personal data breach and will notify you and any applicable regulator of a breach where we are required to do so.

It may be necessary to send your personal data to third parties outside the EEA as part of a transaction, where the privacy and data protection laws may not be as protective as those in your jurisdiction. For example, passport information may be sent in order to obtain airport passes necessary for engine or aircraft inspection. Such data would not

be sent without your express consent and knowledge as to the recipient. In these sorts of cases PremiAero will seek assurances that the third party will respect the security of your personal data and treat it in accordance with all applicable laws.

Disclosure of your Information

We do not sell your personal information to third parties for marketing purposes. We may disclose information to third parties if you consent to us doing so as well as in the following circumstances:

You agree that we have the right to share your personal information with the following recipients or categories of recipients:

- Any department or authorised person within our company.
- Selected third parties including:
 - business partners, suppliers and sub-contractors for the performance of any contract we enter into with them or you in relation to the Services;
 - government agencies, authorities or departments for the purposes of complying with any travel, transportation or security requirements in relation to the Services;
 - banking and other financial institutions in relation to the leasing or supply of any particular aircraft under or as part of the Services;
 - credit reference agencies for the purpose of assessing your credit score to the extent this is a condition of us entering into a contract with you.

We will disclose your personal information to third party recipients:

- in the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we will disclose your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of our business or assets.
- if PremiAero or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by it about its customers will be one of the transferred assets.
- if we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any law, legal obligation or court order, or in order to enforce rights under the GDPR or other agreements.
- to protect our rights, property or safety, our customers, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for the maintenance and security of the Site and Services.

Your rights

Under the applicable data protection laws you have various rights over your personal information: You have the right to:

- Request access to your personal data, commonly known as a 'subject access request' or "SAR". This enables you to receive a copy of the personal data we hold about you. Please be aware that in order to process SARs we will require proof of your identification.
- Request that we correct the personal data we hold about you. This enables you
 to have an incomplete or inaccurate data we hold about you corrected, although
 note that we may need to verify the accuracy of the new data you provide to us.
- Ask us to erase your personal data in certain circumstances. Please note however that there may be circumstances where you ask us to erase your personal data but we are legally required or entitled to retain it.
- Where we are processing your data under the legitimate interest condition, then you may object to this processing, or request that the processing is restricted, if there is something about your particular situation which makes you want to object to processing on this ground as you feel it impacts on your fundamental rights and freedoms. Note that there may be circumstances where you object to, or ask us to restrict, our processing of your personal data but we are legally required or entitled to continue to processing your personal data and/or to refuse your request. In some cases, we may demonstrate that we have a compelling legitimate ground to process your information which override your rights and freedoms.
- Where we have asked you for consent to process your data, you may withdraw this consent at any time by contacting office@premiaero.co.uk
- Please note however that we may still be entitled to process your personal data if we have another legitimate reason (other than consent) for doing so.

Changes to this policy

Any changes made to this Policy from time to time will be published at the Site.

Any material or other change to the data processing operations described in this Policy which is relevant to or impacts on you or your personal data, will be notified to you in advance by email. In this way, you will have an opportunity to consider the nature and impact of the change and exercise your rights under the GDPR in relation to that change (e.g., to withdraw consent or to object to the processing) as you see fit.
